

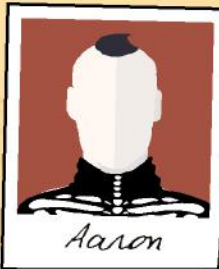
MURDER MYSTERY PUZZLE

I was the only person sitting on a chair. I was alone in a house.

*'beside' =
to the left, right, up, or down, in the same room

① There was no empty room

② There was exactly one person on a bed.



I was either in the left-most or in the right-most column.



I was beside a bed.



I was on the row directly above Aaron.
I was not beside a pumpkin.



I was in front of a window, or behind a window.



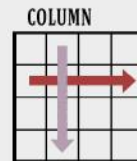
I was beside a TV.



The Victim. He is in the last remaining position.

Everyone was in a different row and column



if A is here :

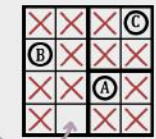


then no one can be in these spots :



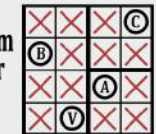
Find everyone's position to find the victim

the victim can only be here

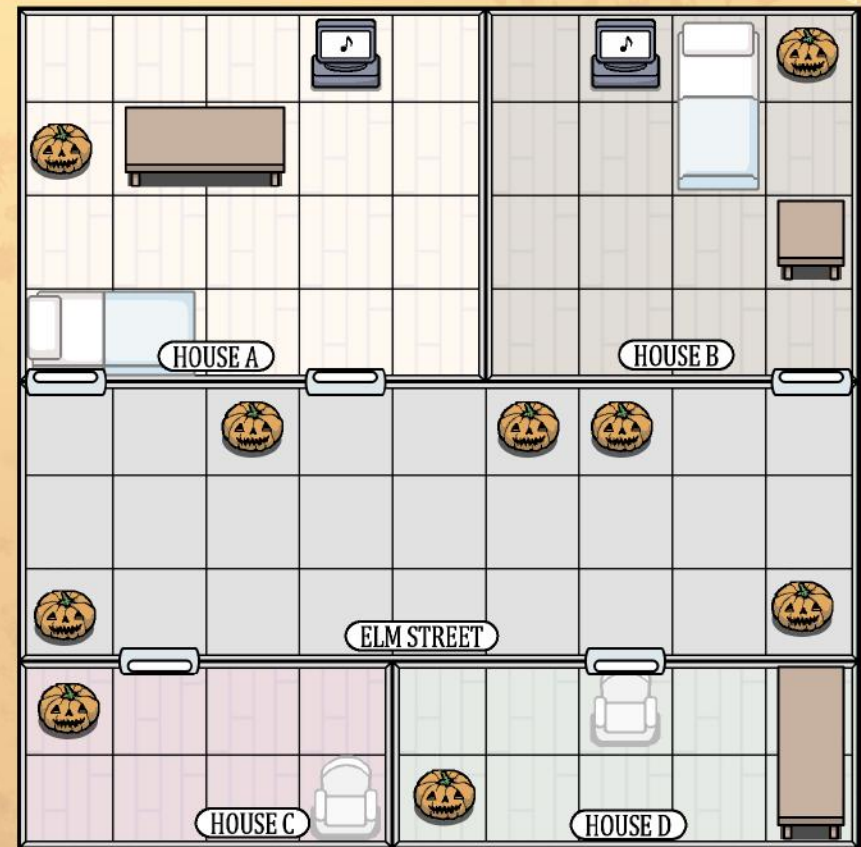


Whoever is in the victim's room is the murderer
